June 2015's monthly index of economic activity, Imacec

According to preliminary information, last June the Imacec rose 2.7% over the same month a year before. The seasonally-adjusted series increased 1.1% with respect to the previous month, and 3.1% in twelve months. The month came with the same number of working days as June 2014.

The result reflected, mainly, the increase in manufacturing and mining activity.

In accordance with the calendar for the disclosure of National Accounts figures, preliminary GDP results for the second quarter of the year, together with revisions to first-quarter figures, will be published next 18 August.
