June 2017's monthly index of economic activity, Imacec

According to preliminary information, last June the IMACEC rose 1.4% over the same month a year before. The seasonally-adjusted series increased 0.5% with respect to the previous month, and rose 1.4% in twelve months. The month came with the same number of working days as June 2016.

The mining IMACEC fell 0.9%, while the non-mining index rose 1.6%, reflecting the increase in services and trade activity, whose effect was partly offset by the drop in construction and manufacturing. In seasonally-adjusted terms, and with respect to the previous month, the mining IMACEC fell 0.9% and the non-mining IMACEC grew 0.6%.

As per the calendar of National Accounts publication, preliminary GDP figures for the second quarter of this year, together with revisions to the first quarter, will be published next Friday 18 August.
