June 2018's monthly index of economic activity, IMACEC

According to preliminary information, last June the Imacec rose 4.9% over the same month a year before. The seasonally-adjusted series diminished 0.1% with respect to the previous month and rose 4.5% in twelve months. The month came with the same number of working days as June 2017.

The mining Imacec increased 3.7%, while the non-mining index rose 5.0%, influenced by the performance of trade and manufacturing activity. In seasonally-adjusted terms, and with respect to the previous month, the mining Imacec dropped 2.7% and the non-mining Imacec rose 0.2%.

As per the calendar for the publication of National Accounts figures, second-quarter 2018 preliminary GDP results, together with revisions to the first quarter, will be released next 20 August.
