March 2016's monthly index of economic activity, IMACEC

According to preliminary information, last March the Imacec rose 2.1% over the same month a year before. The seasonally-adjusted series dropped 0.1% with respect to the previous month, and increased 2.3% in twelve months. The month came with the same number of working days as March 2015.

The result reflected, mainly, growth in services activities.

In accordance with the calendar for the disclosure of National Accounts figures, preliminary GDP results for the first quarter of this year will be released next 18 May.
